

# Activity Guidelines

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## Come on time and plan to have fun!

1. We understand that we are witnesses for Christ and must conduct ourselves accordingly; in words, actions, dress, etc.
2. Use the buddy system. Minimum persons for buddy groups: 2 for same gender, 5 for mixed genders. If you need to leave the group for any reason let one of the leaders know. You are not allowed to go beyond established boundaries.
3. No illegal or controlled substances. No electronic entertainment equipment of any type is to be brought to any youth group function without the prior consent of a leader. If you want to know why please ask a leader.
4. Any prescribed medications should be brought to the attention of the leader (s) beforehand.
5. When swimming or water sports are involved, proper attire is required. Proper attire includes nothing bare except head, neck arms and legs (from mid-thigh down). Please remember that we are trying to be respectful of one another and not create temptation.  
Girls: -modest one piece bathing suits,  
-shorts and t-shirts, or  
-modest cover-up  
(Belly shirts, hip huggers, and spaghetti strap tank tops do not fit these guidelines.)  
Boys: -modest bathing suits  
(should fit so that boxers don't show)  
-shorts and t-shirts  
-underwear should not be seen.  
(if pants are not worn on the waste, a shirt should cover any exposed underwear)
6. If these rules are not followed, your parent/guardian will be called and notified of the situation. Your parent/guardian may have to pick you up wherever you may be.

We have established these event guidelines for the safety and protection of our youth. Please present the permission slip below to the leader handling the registration. Extra spending money is often handy to have (up to the discretion of parent /guardian ).
